In the framework of the European Union-funded project "*EU 4 Border Security*", the IOM invites interested eligible Suppliers to submit Quotations for the supply, delivery and installation of 6 (six) floating docks.

The floating docks should be brand new, in accordance to the Technical specifications enlisted in Annex C (which is attached) and manufactured for use in Europe i.e. to be compliant with European weather conditions.

Additional services:

The supplier shall also be responsible for the installation of floating docks at special designated places in the following districts of the Republic of Moldova: (1 item in *Ocnița district*; 2 items in *Soroca district*; 2 item in *Ștefan-Vodă district*; 1 item in *Gagauz Autonomous Territorial Unit*).

Terms of warranty:

Official warranty for the docks shall be valid on the territory of Moldova without any concerns.

Information to suppliers:

With this RFQ is the General Instructions to Suppliers (GIS) which include the Instructions to Suppliers, Technical Specifications and administrative requirements that Suppliers will need to follow in order to prepare and submit their quotation for consideration by IOM.

The language of the Quotation shall be Romanian, Russian or English and prices shall be quoted in EUR, Delivery at Place (DAP) Chisinau (Incoterms – 2010), with VAT 0%, exemption of excise and

custom duties acc. to the Government Decision of the Republic of Moldova nr. 246 of 08.04.2010. In case other currency is offered, the comparison of offers will be based on the prevailing IOM rate of exchange (link to the website with rates https://treasury.un.org/operationalrates/OperationalRates.php).

The Quotation shall remain valid for a minimum period of 45 calendar days, after the deadline for submission.

IOM shall evaluate and compare the Quotations based on the following:

(a) Compliance with technical specifications and warranty requirements.

(b) Delivery schedule.

(c) Price.
